

Did you attend, view, or organize a funeral during the pandemic?

We're looking for volunteers to share their experiences.

Collège Boréal is partnering with the Ontario Association of Cemetery and Funeral Professionals (OACFP) to help them identify and evaluate the impact of COVID-19 on their industry's practices and consumers.

We're inviting you to take part in an anonymous 15-minute survey to share experiences with the bereavement sector & thoughts and wishes for your own funeral. Share your experiences and you will have the chance to win one of six \$100 prizes. The survey is open to anyone over the age of 19 living in Canada, and we're especially hoping to recruit people who interacted with the funeral services industry during the pandemic – whether by organizing, attending, or being invited to a funeral, life celebration private viewing, streamed or recorded funeral, or graveside ceremony.

Findings will be used to design a bilingual toolkit to support bereavement professionals navigating emerging challenges caused by the pandemic. Findings will be used to help improve services to bereaved families and adapt teaching curricula for students in funeral services.

This study has been approved by the Comité d'Éthique de la Recherche au Collège Boréal. This study is a part of the project "Understanding the Canadian Way of Death by advancing and strengthening innovations in services, rituals and human resources in Ontario's post COVID-19 Bereavement Sector."
